Dear Parents,

We are excited to announce that Friday 6th December we will be hosting Butler Primary School's second annual Colour Explosion. Last year was such a huge success and brought funds into our P&C to help kick start the much-needed revamp of our undercover area. This year we are hoping to raise \$30,000 to finalize the revamp. This letter contains all the important information you need to prepare for the day.

When is the Colour Explosion?

The Colour Explosion will be held on Friday 6th December from 12pm (exact time to be confirmed)

Where is it held?

The Colour Explosion will be held on our school oval.

What if my child wants to run but does not want coloured powder thrown on them?

Students wishing to not be doused in coloured powder are asked to wear a coloured shirt. This will notify our volunteers that they do not wish to have powder thrown on them. While we will endeavour to keep them powder free, we can not guarantee 100% that no powder will get on them throughout the event.

What if I don't want my child to participate?

We encourage all students to participate as this is a great end of year event for everyone involved. However, if you don't wish for your child to participate, there is a form that will need to be signed in the front office to notify us that your child will not be participating. This can be filled out and left in the P&C box in the front office. If we do not receive the signed form to remove your child from the event, then they will be expected to participate in the Colour Explosion. Students not participating will still be expected to attend school that day and will go to the oval with their class, but will stay in the gazebos while their class runs (unless other wise organised with admin).

Does my child need to bring their lunch on the day?

Sausage sizzles will be available for PRE-ORDER ONLY (order form attached) It is entirely up to you if your child brings their own lunch or orders a sausage sizzle. Lunch will be eaten in class rooms before the event. The canteen will be closed on the day. Each child will also receive a Berri Quelch Juice stick (icy pole) after running their lap. This is at no charge to the student. You will need to notify your child's teacher if you do not wish for them to receive an icy pole. Orders can be placed in the PandC drop box in the office. Orders MUST be placed before the 4th December. No late orders will be accepted. PLEASE USE ONE ORDER FORM PER STUDENT.

What about the Purple Kindy Group?

ALL students are invited to attend and we would love to see them all having a great time. Purple Kindy students can stay with parents until the Kindy classes are called to run (Kindy classes run first).

What is in the colour powder?

98% Corn Starch

2% Permitted Food colour

Gluten Free, Non Toxic, Non Flammable, Biodegradable, Enviromentally Friendly and skin safe.

What about my Child's eyes?

Each participating student will receive a pair of UV400 sunglasses to protect their eyes. These are for the students to keep. Our volunteers will be aiming powder from the torso down but again we can not 100% guarantee powder will not get on their face.

Where do we leave Cash donations?

Cash donations along with the filled out form at the back of the fundraising booklet, need to be placed in a sealed envelope and left in the P&C box in the front office by the 15th November.

How do we fundraise and order our prizes?

There are 2 options. Cash or online. The fundraising booklet has all the information for setting up your students online account and prizes can be ordered on there. If you choose the cash option you can choose your prizes on the form at the back of the booklet before you hand it in and we will order the prizes for you.

What does my child need to wear?

We are asking students and teachers (and parents who want to participate in the family run) to wear white T-shirts for best effect. If your child has a coloured shirt on, we will assume that they do not want the powder to be thrown on them. Please be sure to not allow them to wear sleeveless shirts as it will be a very sunny day. If needed shirts can be purchased from Kmart and Best and Less for as little a \$3. Students can wear their white shirts to school that morning. Normal school bottoms are expected to be worn on the day. THIS IS NOT A FREE DRESS DAY.
